

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH THE NORTH CENTRAL TEXAS COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS TO FUND THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE COTTON BELT SHARED USE TRAIL; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Carrollton (City) and the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) mutually desire to enter into an Interlocal Cooperative Agreement (ICA) to allow the design and construction of the Cotton Belt shared use trail between the Downtown Carrollton and McInnish Park, along the Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) Silver Line; and

WHEREAS, the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) has recommitted funding to extend the Cotton Belt shared use trail into McInnish Park; and

WHEREAS, local match funding in an amount of \$832,202 from the City is necessary for the Cotton Belt Trail and extension into McInnish Park; and

WHEREAS, an ICA with NCTCOG is necessary in order to allow the City to fund the local match for the design and construction of these shared use trail projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

All of the above premises are found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council, and they are hereby approved, ratified and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2

The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute an ICA with NCTCOG for the local match funding for the design and construction of the Cotton Belt Trail and extension.

SECTION 3

The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4

This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
