

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A PROJECT SPECIFIC AGREEMENT WITH DALLAS COUNTY FOR STREET OVERLAY PROJECTS ON STREETS LOCATED WITHIN PARK TERRACE SUBDIVISION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Carrollton (“City”) executed Resolution 4674 authorizing the City Manager to enter into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement (“ILA”) with Dallas County (“County”) whereby the County agreed to provide road and bridge maintenance, repairs, and improvements on Type “B”, Type “C”, and Type “E” roadways situated within the territorial limits and jurisdiction of the City, with maintenance, repairs, and improvements of Type “E” roadways to be fully funded and paid for by the City;

WHEREAS, the County requires an execution of a Project Specific Agreement (“PSA”) to supplement the ILA for specific projects;

WHEREAS, the City desires Dallas County to perform such maintenance, repairs, and improvements on Type “E” roads, as more fully described and identified on Exhibit “A” of the PSA (the “Project”);

WHEREAS, City will provide funding for the Project in the amount of \$675,424.99; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, as amended, provides authorization for a local government to contract with one or more local governments to perform governmental functions and services to increase their efficiency and effectiveness;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

All of the above premises are found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council, and they are hereby approved, ratified, and incorporated into the body of the Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to enter into a PSA with Dallas County for milling and overlay of the existing street surfaces of various streets located within Park Terrace Subdivision. The City of Carrollton will provide funding in the amount not to exceed \$675,424.99.

SECTION 3.

The City Manager or designee is authorized to take those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
