

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH N. HARRIS COMPUTER CORPORATION FOR THE PURCHASE AND IMPLEMENTATION OF CITYVIEW SOFTWARE AND RELATED SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$717,189.00; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Carrollton, Texas (“City”) has adopted a management philosophy of continuous improvement, and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that the City acquire a modern operational software support system to improve the productivity, efficiency and effectiveness of the Development Services Department and the Environmental Services Department, and

WHEREAS, the City issued a formal request for proposal (RFP #16-027) for a comprehensive permitting, planning, code enforcement, business licensing, rental housing and cashiering software suite; and has received several proposals in response to the RFP; and

WHEREAS, upon a thorough review and consideration of the various proposals, and all matters attendant and related thereto, the City staff recommends that the CityView proposal by N. Harris Computer Corporation should be approved, and that the City Manager shall be authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City of Carrollton in an amount not to exceed \$717,189.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

The above and foregoing premises are found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2

The requested revised proposal by N. Harris Computer Corporation, having been reviewed by the City staff and found to be acceptable and in the best interests of the City and its citizens, are hereby in all things approved.

SECTION 3

The City Manager is authorized to take those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4

This Resolution shall take effect upon passage.
