

RESOLUTION NO. _____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE CARROLLTON POLICE RESERVE PURSUANT TO THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, CODE OF ORDINANCES, SECTION 35.60, WHICH AUTHORIZES THE CREATION OF THE POLICE RESERVE UNIT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Carrollton Police Department (“Department”) recognizes the necessity to supplement the Department, under special needs and circumstances, with a voluntary police reserve unit; and

WHEREAS, Section 35.60 of the City of Carrollton Code of Ordinances establishes the Carrollton Police Reserve, a voluntary police reserve unit separate and distinct from the Department; and

WHEREAS, Section 35.60(B) of the City of Carrollton Code of Ordinances authorizes the Chief of Police to appoint members to the Carrollton Police Reserve;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS; THAT:

SECTION 1:

All of the above premises are found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council, and they are hereby approved, ratified, and incorporated into the body of the Resolution as if copied in their entirety.

SECTION 2:

The City Council of the City of Carrollton hereby authorizes the City Manager, or her designee, to approve the appointment of the following individuals, in a form to be approved by the City Attorney, to become authorized members and Reserve Officers of the Carrollton Police Reserve:

Whitney Wallace; and

Gregg Andersson; and

Brian Box.

SECTION 3:

The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4:

This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
