A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE 2025 SUSTAINABILITY PLAN AS THE CITY'S STRATEGIC FRAMEWORK FOR PROMOTING ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP, SOCIAL EQUITY, AND ECONOMIC RESILIENCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Carrollton, Texas (the "City"), is a Home Rule Municipality possessing the full power of local self-government pursuant to Article XI, Section 5 of the Texas Constitution, Section 51.072 of the Texas Local Government Code, and its Home Rule Charter; and

WHEREAS, the City of Carrollton is committed to enhancing the quality of life for its residents through strategic planning that balances economic development, environmental protection, and social equity; and

WHEREAS, the City, in continuance of its commitment to sustainability and in alignment with globally recognized standards such as the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals has developed the 2025 Sustainability Plan (the "Plan"), a comprehensive document outlining key priorities and initiatives to advance the City's long-term sustainable objectives; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has duly reviewed the Plan and finds it to be in the best interests of the City to adopt the Plan as a framework for promoting the principles of sustainability, resilience, and equity to ensure the prosperity, vitality, and well-being of current and future generations of Carrollton residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1

The above premises are found to be true and correct legislative and factual findings of the City Council and are hereby approved, ratified, and incorporated into the body of this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2

The 2025 Sustainability Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes, is hereby adopted as the City's strategic plan for advancing sustainability within the City of Carrollton.

SECTION 3

The City Manager is authorized to take those steps reasonable and necessary to comply with the intent of this Resolution.

SECTION 4

This Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
