ORDINANCE NO. 3720

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE # 3367–3720 DESIGNATING THE NUMBER OF POSITIONS IN EACH CLASSIFICATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS IN THE CARROLLTON FIRE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR SAVINGS, REPEAL, AND SERVABILITY CLAUSES; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The number of positions and classifications of firefighters within the Carrollton Fire Department shall be:

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance does not affect the right of the Fire Chief to appoint one person to the classification of Assistant Chief.

SECTION 3.

<u>Savings</u>. This Ordinance shall be cumulative of all other ordinances of the City, and shall not repeal any of the provisions of those ordinances except in those instances where the provisions of those ordinances are in direct conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance; provided, however, that any complaint, notice, action, cause of action, or claim which prior to the effective date of this Ordinance has been initiated or has arisen under or pursuant to such other ordinance(s) shall continue to be governed by the provisions of that ordinance or those ordinances, and for that purpose that ordinance or those ordinances shall be deemed to remain and shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4.

Severability. The sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases, clauses and words of this Ordinance are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, phrase, clause or word in this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and the City Council hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions of this Ordinance despite such invalidity, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5.

<u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect <u>immediately on January 1, 2017</u> upon its adoption and publication in accordance with and as provided by law and the City Charter.
