Consider <u>Approval For The Purchase Of Additional Travel Services For The Carrollton Senior Center</u> <u>From Cruise One</u>, In An Amount Of \$46,500.00, For A Revised Total Purchase Amount Not To Exceed \$143,310.00.

BACKGROUND:

The intent of this memo is to request additional funding for Cruise One for an extended trip for FY2017. This trip is a cruise to the Panama Canal. The date for travel is March 28, 2017. The cost is approximately \$4,739 per person and is dependent on cabin location and occupancy. On June 7, 2016, City Council approved funding for \$97,000.00, item #13. We had an unexpected interest for this trip and an additional 10 passengers signed up after the down payment was made.

Staff does obtain three quotes for the trips; however other factors are included such as exact location of tour, excursions during the tour, customer evaluations on previous trips, etc. There is no HUB vendor listed for tour companies.
