Consider And Take Final Action On An Ordinance For A Mutual Boundary Adjustment With The City Of Plano And The Town Of Hebron For Certain Tracts Of Land Located Along Marsh Lane, Hebron Parkway, Park Boulevard And Plano Parkway. Case No. 02-19MD2 Mutual Boundary Adjustment.

BACKGROUND:

The cities of Carrollton and Plano and the Town of Hebron have been discussing a mutual boundary adjustment along several streets with mutual boundaries. The intent of this adjustment is to ensure that street right-of-way is within one city or another in a manner that is logical and relatively easy to determine. This adjustment will ensure consistency for such items as roadway maintenance, emergency response and law enforcement.

No private property is being affected by this boundary adjustment.
